The Cornerstone Cares Fund is funded by <u>voluntary</u>, monthly donations from hundreds of caring team members who want to help other team members through a crisis, when the team member has no other financial resources available. A committee comprised of Marc Laird, Judy Belanger, Adam Laird, Gene Humphries and Mary Dinkins have established specific guidelines for the approval and distribution of funds to team members in need, subject to the validation and approval by the team member's Executive Manager. Any team member can alert the Committee about a fellow team member situation.

Since its inception, the Cornerstone Cares Fund has distributed over \$1,050,000 to help more than 400 team members deal with a personal crisis when they had no other source to help them.
